For the REM Craft Fair, we utilize various avenues for advertising, including Road Signs, Radio, Newspaper, Cable Access TV, Facebook, Chamber Newsletter, Various Community Calendars, Posters and Postcards placed in area businesses and more. Even with all the advertising we do, WORD of MOUTH will always be the best form of advertising. Please share the REM Craft Fair Facebook page and event with your friends. When the time comes, please email the poster to your friends, family and customers and post in your neighborhoods. When you are attending other craft fairs, have a list of the fairs at which you will be selling to hand out to your paying customers so they can find you at future fairs. This will help advertise the REM Craft Fair as well.

## 2022 CRAFTER AGREEMENT October 22-23, 2022 9am-3pm (For Crafter Files)

- **1.)** I agree that I am a <u>Maine Resident selling my own Maine made items</u>. Crafters attempting to sell fraudulent or commercially produced merchandise will be asked to leave and will not be invited back to participate in subsequent fairs.
- 2.) Crafters may only display and sell their Maine made items that are listed on the back of their application. RETURNING CRAFTERS with new items those need to be juried, please send pictures via email: artisans@rem1.org
- **3.)** Crafters assume full responsibility for their property brought onto the premises and will not hold REM or anyone else responsible for any damages, personal injury, customer turnout, sales or theft that may occur before, during and after this fair. (Note: Security will be provided for Friday and Saturday nights.)
- **4.)** Crafters are NOT permitted to use duct tape, nails or other destructive means of hanging advertisements, displays or products on the walls or floor. **Each crafter, not REM, will be financially responsible for any damage to the Champions' venue and will not be invited back to participate in subsequent fairs.**
- 5.) Table and/or booth set-up: Crafters are responsible for bringing their own table(s) (unless rented from REM), chair(s), and booth set-up. We ask that tables be covered, to the floor, if possible. Crafters are responsible for making sure their display does not damage the floor by providing appropriate protection/pads, under any part of each display unit that touches the floor. When moving the display units, do not drag them as this will cause damage to the floor.
- **6.) BOOTH ASSIGNMENT**: If you have any requests regarding booth assignment, THIS MUST be indicated on your application. We will do our best to honor specific preferences; however, there is no guarantee due to layout constraints. Placement is based on returning artisans and a first come first request basis. We do our <u>VERY BEST</u> to honor requests. Competing crafters will <u>NOT</u> be placed in the immediate vicinity of one another.
- **7.)** Crafters who sell opened food at their space must cover their entire floor spacing. Ex. Fudge, Brownies, Jams/Jellies, Pickles, etc. Please get in touch with us should you have any questions. Call 207-873-4444 or reply to this email.
- **8.)** Each crafter is invited to donate an item valued at \$10-\$30 along with a business card to display with it for a raffle/silent auction to be held during the craft fair. Participating crafters will be entered in a drawing for a \$25 VISA gift card.
- **9.)** Crafters are responsible for any items returned by customers.
- **10.)** Crafters are responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax when applicable.
- **11.)** When listing items that you're selling at the REM Craft Fair, please list the general categories being sold. Example: If selling Jewelry, just list necklaces, bracelets, earrings, etc. or shampoos, lotions, soaps if selling Body Products. No need to list the specific individual jewelry pieces or body products you'll be bringing. Items not listed will not be allowed to be sold. Please contact us 2 weeks prior should you have new products.
- 12.) COVID Requirements- We will follow CDC recommendations for large indoor events.
- **13.)** Payment is non-refundable after JUNE 30TH -- 50% refund on or before JUNE 30TH. Reimbursements will not be given for NO SHOWS. NO SHOWS with NO communication will not be invited back.

## 2022 REM CRAFT FAIR Bonus Information

Customer Appreciation Prize drawing: Due to customer positive feedback, REM will again hold a Customer Appreciation drawing at the end of each day and award a \$25 VISA gift card to a winning customer. Crafters will need to give a customer appreciation entry ticket (provided by REM) to each customer who makes a purchase (1 per paying customer). The customer will then need to fill out the ticket and put it in the designated box near the back of the fair. If you need more tickets during the day, let us know. A different colored door prize ticket will be distributed each day. Thank you for your cooperation, and we hope this will encourage more sales.

**Directions:** Take Exit 130 off I-95, towards Waterville. After the second light, enter the shopping center parking lot (before McDonald's). Champions Fitness Club is located to the left at the end of the parking area between Olympia Sports and J.C. Penney. Check website <a href="https://www.rem1.org">www.rem1.org</a> for a map.

Parking: Once you have unloaded your vehicle, please move your vehicle to the designated parking areas for crafters: area behind J.C. Penney or area near Main St.

**Registration Table:** Crafters should check in at the **REGISTRATION Table** near the entrance when they arrive to receive their booth assignments and other information. This table will be staffed throughout the Craft Fair if you have questions or concerns.

Set-up: Friday afternoon (October 21) set-up is available between the hours of 4pm and 7pm at Champions. On Saturday (Oct. 22), plan to set up between 7am and 9am. On Sunday (Oct. 23), crafters can access the fair venue starting at 8am. Security will be there both nights.

Booths may not be taken down before 3pm on Sunday unless inventory has been depleted. Please keep your set-up within the space allotted to you. If your display encroaches outside your space, it could create a potential hazard, and you'll be asked to immediately address this problem. **Please remember to clean up your space.** 

A sign is recommended to identify your booth. Please bring a supply of business cards, as visitors to the fair appreciate them.

Please bring enough cash to make change, REM will be unable to make change.

**Complimentary coffee and baked items** will be available to you and helpers until 8:45am Sat. and Sun. mornings. Tickets for these will be in your registration packets.
